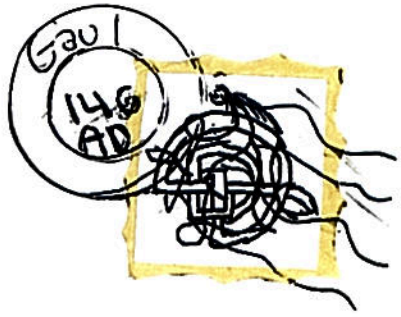

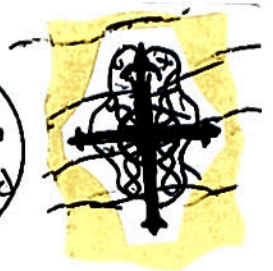


Hey guys,
